

Dependents of E Visa Holders
Required Documents and Submission Instructions
U.S. Embassy Buenos Aires

The procedures outlined here for dependent applications pertain only to qualifying family members who are applying **separately** from their respective principal applicant, after the principal applicant has been issued an E visa by a U.S. consulate or embassy. If you are applying as a dependent (spouse or child under age 21) of a current E visa holder, send the following documents to BNS-TreatyVisas@state.gov, and bring them with to the Consulate on the day of the interview:

1. Confirmation of appointment and payment.
2. DS-160 confirmation page for all dependents.
3. Proof of legal relationship between the principal applicant and any dependents, e.g., original government-issued birth and/or marriage certificates, adoption papers, etc.
4. One 2×2 inch passport-style photograph for each applicant, taken on plain white background within the last six months (if your photograph could not be uploaded to your online DS-160).
5. A photocopy of the principal applicant's E visa.

Please Note:

- If your E visa application is for a family group, please ensure payments have been made for all family members.
- Under no circumstances should an applicant reschedule or cancel their E visa appointment in the visa appointment system. If changes are required, you must contact the Buenos Aires E visa team at BNS-TreatyVisas@state.gov.
- All applicants age 14 years and older as well as those under the age of 80 must appear for a personal interview.
- The Consular Office reserves the right to request additional documents.
